**7. Master Teacher Tip of the Week - Mastering Meetings**

In any disagreement, look for one point on which you can agree with the other person. Even if the point is small, pick one point you can agree with and add a concession. By conceding a point immediately, you show you're not defensive and that you want to solve the problem-not duck blame or make excuses.
